STRATEGY STATEMENT

The Strategic School Improvement Plan for the Spring/Summer term 2020-2021 has four targets:

1. Wellbeing
2. Assessment
3. GAP analysis
4. Quality 1st teaching.

Our plan for spending the COVID catch up grant is based on plugging the gaps following our gap analysis.

We identified the gaps in children's learning through quality 1st teaching and continuous assessment since the children's return from Lockdown. As a result of analysing the data, our findings show that the children who did little work during lockdown have fallen significantly behind the children who completed their home schooling.

We aim to close the gaps by intense teaching programs for small groups running during the Easter holiday, before the school day and during the school day.

The progress of the pupils will be monitored by SLT and reported to governors. We have read articles from many sources but particularly the Education Endowment Foundation (EEF) as to the best value for money strategies. These will be reviewed by the SLT to optimise our use of the COVID catch up premium. Baseline assessment of ALL children.
